REQUIREMENTS FOR ANIMAL THERAPISTS

The Animal Therapists

- **must have a sweet, affectionate, friendly disposition.**
- **must be able to socialize well with other animals and with people.**
- **must be capable of entering new situations with confidence. The animal cannot react negatively to loud noises, wheel chairs, medical carts and other normal sights, smells and sounds of a hospital situation.**
- **should have the stamina to complete an hour long visit**
- **Formal obedience training is not required. A calm, friendly, outgoing personality is more important than performance. A basic understanding of sit & stay commands is preferred. The animal must be kept under control and at the handler's side at all times.**
- **All dogs and cats must be at least one year old and have proof of all shot requirements given by a veterinarian.**
- **All dog and cat therapists must remain on leash or harness during visits.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR ANIMAL HANDLERS

The Handler

- **must accept full responsibility for their animal's actions and must be in complete control of the animal at all times.**
- **must be willing to attend a minimum of 1 visit per month.**
- **must enjoy meeting people and adding joy to their lives.**
- **must attend a mandatory orientation and pass the pet/handler evaluation.**
- **must satisfactorily complete a 4 visit probationary training period**
- **must be at least 18 years of age**
